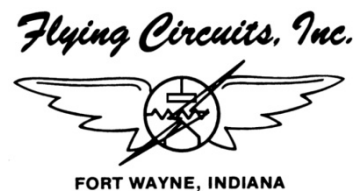

ANNUAL DUES:

AGREEMENT UNDERTAKEN WITH RESPECT TO INSTRUCTION IN PILOTING RADIO CONTROLLED MODELS AND THE USE OF THE FLYING SITE AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT.

This Agreement is entered into this _____ day of _____ 20____ by and between the Fort Wayne Flying Circuits, Inc., an Indiana corporation, hereafter referred to as FWFC and

_____ (Hereafter referred to as the Member).

Whereas, FWFC has officially designated by action of its Board of Directors certain of its members as instructors, said designation indicating it reasonably believes said individuals to be proficient in the piloting of radio controlled model aircraft and capable of imparting said knowledge.

Whereas, the Member, having already joined FWFC and wishing to receive instruction in the piloting of radio controlled model aircraft and, whereas, the Member's use of FWFC flying sites, field equipment, or any other associated item used in any and all FWFC functions the following applies:

Now, therefore, in consideration of FWFC allowing its designated instructors to teach piloting skills to the Member and for and in consideration of said member receiving such instruction from one or more designated instructors, and the Member's use of any FWFC flying site and/or associated equipment, the following shall constitute the terms and agreement between these parties:

1. The Member shall at all times of receipt of said instruction have then maintained in full force and effect a current membership in the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) and shall abide by all rules and regulations of the FWFC and AMA in maintaining insurance coverage and obeying all safety instructions and rules.
2. The Member understands and agrees that he or she assumes all risks with respect to damage of property or injury to his or her model and equipment during instruction, whether said loss or damage occurs during his or her control of the model or during the instructor's control, and whether such loss or damage occurs as a result of mechanical or electronic failure or "pilot error".
3. The Member understands and agrees that he or she assumes all risks with respect to damage of property or injury to themselves or any other person or persons resulting from mechanical or electronic failure of any nature or "pilot error", on his or her part or on the instructors part, all of which may cause property damage and/or personal injury.
4. The Member agrees to personally hold harmless, indemnify, and defend the instructor and/or FWFC from any and all claims, suits, causes of action or assertions of liability of any nature whatsoever arising out of, or by virtue of any damage, loss, or injury as described in Paragraph #3, supra, and to do so regardless of insurance coverage that may be applicable and regardless of whether he or she or the instructor are in control of the model at the time
5. The Member agrees to assume all risks with the respect to the use of FWFC flying sites and all or any FWFC equipment and to hold harmless, indemnify, and defend the FWFC from any and all claims, suits, causes of action, or assertions of liability of any nature whatsoever arising out of or by virtue of any damage loss or injury arising from member's use of FWFC flying sites, field maintenance equipment, or any other equipment owned or employed by FWFC.
