Vintage Qualified: Any plane that was designed for RC and was kit-
ted, published, or flown (attested to by the builder) and meets the
following classifications—

Pioneer: Before January 1955

Classic: Before January 1965

Nostalgia: Before January 1984 (35 years ago from current year)



Designs can be scaled up or down. Modern engines and electric power are welcome. Modern radios are encouraged. There are ARF balsa planes that qualify and some kits are available to build your favorite. Long neglected oldies can be restored.

Saturday: First up is **Pioneer** period with demonstration by SAM 28 from 9:00 until 10:00. Then open flying for **Classic** and **Nostalgia** until dusk. Lunch is available at the field clubhouse. Guests are Welcome!

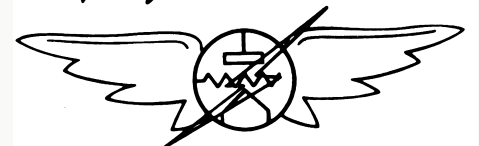
